## **New Business:**

Webster Martin 1440 Townline Rd would like to divide a property on Ridge Road parcel #51-01-1-1, a 47 acre parcel into two 20+ acre parcels to create an access lane to an otherwise landlocked parcel he owns. Motion was made by Bob, second by Floyd, to authorize Chairman to sign for this lot line adjustment approval carried by all.

**Area Variance**: John Cowell 903 Serenity Rd, has applied for an area variance to combine 3 contiguous non-conforming parcels he owns on Serenity Road into two non-conforming parcels. He would then request the adjoining lot line to be moved 61.83' towards the southern parcel lot line.

Motion by Bob seconded Mike to recommend approval of this area variance contingent on the approval of engineer designing wastewater system on newly created parcel. This carried by Bob, Floyd, Ellen, Mike with George Abstaining.
