From the Desk of Town Supervisor (*Pat Flynn*):

- The approval on November 6, 2018 of the Benton Water District #1 extension allows the Town of Torrey Water District #1 to go forward
- The Town of Torrey on November 18, 2018 was awarded by the USDA a loan for Water District #1 in the amount of \$892,000
- Application for Water District 1 (the Northeast area of the Town) submitted to the NYS Controller's Office for approval
- Filed State Environmental Quality Review Act (**SEQRA**) as lead agency for Water District 1 stating there is non-significant environmental impact for Water District
- The Town of Torrey on November 13, 2018 approved a contract for Timothy McGill, Bond Counsel, for Water District 1
- The Town of Torrey on December 12, 2018 approved and signed a contract with **CPL** engineering team for engineering services for the design and construction of water mains for Water District 1
- On December 19, 2018 received letter from Tom DiNapoli, State Comptroller, approving the Town of Torrey's application for Water District 1 based on a grant of \$684,000 and a loan of \$892,000 from United States Department of Agriculture Rural Development
- Town of Torrey Board met on November 21, 2018 with the trustees of the Village of Dresden at the village's monthly meeting to review and clarify the items in the water contract for the Perry Point Water District (Water District #2)

From the Desk of Town Clerk (Betty Daggett):

- Town Office is open Monday through Thursday from 9:00am - 4:00pm. Call 315-536- 6376
- Tax Collection is in full stride, the new collection system introduced by the county last year was plagued with glitches, problems resolved, the 2019 tax collection is running smoothly.
- New this year, on the tax bills is the option to pay Town & County Taxes online at <https://www.yatescounty.org/519>, - standard processing fees will be applied.
(I have received many calls from taxpayer having problems accessing the county website)
- Fee collection such as building permits, fines & fees issued by Code Office
- Licenses : marriage, hunting, fishing, dog & birth/death certificates (If you love your dog(s), please license them. Licensing helps with Identification of lost dogs and provides protection for the community. It is also NYS Ag & Market law- **ALL** dogs harbored in the Town of Torrey must be licensed *yearly* at the Town Clerk office).

From the Desk of Town Highway Superintendent (Tim Chambers):

- Off hours emergency callout number: 315-729-2706
- Surplus 1992 Gradall was auctioned for \$6700
- Surplus 2008 Dump Truck was auctioned for \$42100
- Highway Department continues to address issues identified in a 2018 Workplace Safety audit
- Identifying which roads in the town will be paved or stoned and oiled in 2019 using Community Highway Improvement Projects (CHIPs) funds
- An engineer is being consulted about a problem on Leach Road
- *Reminder according to NYS law:*

- + throwing trash, garbage, rubbish, litter or refuse on Highways and adjacent lands is prohibited
- + the town superintendent of highways shall sue for and recover a penalty not to exceed \$100 from any person depositing ashes, snow, ice, stones, sticks, etc. upon a highway or on grass or loose stones adjoining a town highway

From the Desk of Town Code Enforcement Officer (*Dwight James*):

- Total Permits issued for 2018 were 89
- Permit fees collected for 2018 were \$8597.81
- Total violations issued were 6 with 5 being resolved
- Reminder all short term rentals must be registered with the Town

From the Desk of Town Planning Board (*Dave Granzin*):

- Meets the third (3rd) Monday of the month at 7:00 pm in the Town Building
- Developed regulations on Solar Energy and submitted to the Town Board for approval at the September 11th Town Board meeting
- Investigated the options for dog kennel/breeding regulations
- recommended the Town Board revise the zoning regulations dealing with width requirements for mobile homes/manufactured housing to be in compliance with New York State law passed in 2015

From the Desk of Town Judge (Hon. Matt Conlon)

- Hon. Jean Mashewske resigned effective January 2, 2019
- Hon. Matt Conlon of the Village of Penn Yan is acting judge
- Torrey Town Board on January 8, 2019 appointed George Thompson who will serve the remainder of Judge Mashewske's term starting May 1, 2019

- Court is held each Tuesday at 2:00pm on the West side of the Town Building. The phone number is 315 536 5655
- Criminal court is held the second Tuesday of the month at 2:00 pm
- Town Board members Grant Downs and Larry Martin audited the Town Justice books and found no discrepancies.

From the Desk of Town Watershed Inspector (*Yates Cty Soil & Water*)

The Town's inspectors can be contacted at the Yates County Soil and Water Conservation Department 315- 536-5188.

In November of 2014, the Town of Torrey passed a local Wastewater Law effective January 1, 2015. Under the new law, any onsite wastewater treatment system within 200' of Seneca Lake or a DEC classified stream is required to be inspected every 5 years. The cost of the inspection is borne by the Town of Torrey (unless this is a property transfer). However any pumping of the septic or repair is a cost to the homeowner. We are now in year 5 of these inspections.

- Village tennis courts were repaired and relined this past Summer
- Village of Dresden and Village of Penn Yan have reached an agreement on an amended Authorized Water District Territory
- Town of Torrey and Village of Dresden are finalizing an agreement regarding Water District 2 (Perry Point)
- NYSEG completed a Green Energy Audit for the Village. This led to the replacement of all the florescent in Village buildings with LEDs.

- There is a dire need for volunteer firemen in Dresden. All residents of the Town of Torrey are welcome.

Upcoming Community Event

- **Seneca Lake Pure Waters Association** (SLPWA) again will be doing stream sampling in the Keuka Outlet beginning in April. Sampling is done every 6 weeks throughout the Summer. Harmful Algal Blooms (HABs) monitoring along the Town of Torrey Seneca Lake shoreline will start in late July and continue through Columbus Day weekend.
